### **USCG Aux Boat America Safe Boating Class**

On Saturday September 6th 2025 from 09:00 (9am) to 17:00 (5pm) at the Taunton Yacht Club, the U. S. Coast Guard Auxiliary instructors from Flotilla 6-3 out of Onset-Wareham-Marion presented the Boat America Class to 27 members of the club. We were limited to thirty attendees and had three cancellations. Vice Commodore Catherine Backstrom, from the U.S. Coast Guard Auxiliary and Howard Bibeault, organized the all day event.









### USCG Aux Boat America Safe Boating Class





At the end of the class instruction all attendees had to take a 50 question Federal test and a 10 question Massachusetts test. The Massachusetts test was originally planned only for the attendees age 12-16, but a last minute change at the USCG Aux, indicated that the Massachusetts test would also have to be taken by all attendees to be in compliance with the new law. The instructors were prepared to grade all the 50 question tests for attendees, including one Massachusetts test for an attendee between the ages of 12-16. With the last minute change much more time was required for grading the additional 10 question test.

The Massachusetts test stumped many attendees. The Massachusetts presentation contained a lot of language about the changes that go into effect with the new law. In the end, all attendees passed both tests and received a certificate and a card indicating the class attended. Plus a stick on label indicating that you are a "Graduate of the USCG Aux Safe Boating Course" to be affixed to your boats port side windshield. This would be next to your Vessel Exam Sticker if you have one.

## \*\*\*CLUB REMINDERS\*\*\*

#### Blinds in the Club

- They are made to view through to see the outside
  - But if you list them, please lower before you leave. It helps regulate the temperatures inside the club.

#### Gas Pump

- Remember to LOCK the pump after use.
- The key is returned to the hook in the club.

#### Club Launch

- It should be securely tied after use.
- The engine should be up and out of the water.
- The key is put back on the holder in the club.

#### Grills

- Remember to turn them off and clean up after yourself.
- Place empty propane tanks on the top shelf in the cage.

#### Trash

 Do not put your boat trash in the club trash cans. Please use the dumpster.

#### Dogs

- Must be on leashes.
- Vaccination records on file with the club.
- Clean up after your pet.

#### Lights

Turn them off when leaving (if the club is empty, that is).
